## Materials

1 skein Bernat Velvet (Sandy Cream)
$\mathrm{J} / 6.00 \mathrm{~mm}$ hook
18" diameter circle pillow form
Tapestry needle
Scissors

## Pattern notes

Beginning chain does not count as a stitch.

The pillow cover will be made by crocheting two separate circles and then joined together around the pillow form.

Dimensions: 18" diameter

Gauge: 4"x4" ~ 10 st x 4 rows in double crochet
Abbreviations (US terms):
Ch = chain, dc = double crochet, st = stitch(es)

## Pattern

Round 1: Magic ring, ch 2, 12 dc in ring, join to first dc (12)
Round 2: Ch 2, 2dc in each st around, join to first dc (24)
Round 3: Ch 2, *dc, 2dc, repeat from * around, join to first dc (36)
Round 4: Ch 2, *dc in next 2 st, 2dc, repeat from * around, join to first dc (48)
Round 5: Ch 2, *dc in next 3 st, 2dc, repeat from * around, join to first dc (60)
Round 6: Ch 2, *dc in next 4 st, 2dc, repeat from * around, join to first dc (72)
Round 7: Ch 2, *dc in next 5 st, 2dc, repeat from * around, join to first dc (84)
Round 8: Ch 2, *dc in next 6 st, 2dc, repeat from * around, join to first dc (96)
Round 9: Ch 2, *dc in next 7 st , 2dc, repeat from * around, join to first dc (108)
Round 10: Ch 2, *dc in next 8 st, 2dc, repeat from * around, join to first dc (120)
Round 11: Ch 2, *dc in next 9 st, 2dc, repeat from * around, join to first dc (132)
Round 12: Ch 2, *dc in next 10 st, 2dc, repeat from * around, join to first dc (144)
Fasten off.
Make two circles, do not fasten off after second circle.

## Assembly

With the wrong sides facing together, single crochet the circles together.
Stop a little over $1 / 2$ way around to put in the pillow form.
Continue to single crochet around both circles to close it up.
Join to first single crochet, fasten off, and weave in ends.
