

TEA CAKE SCARF



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TEA CAKE SCARF

Materials:

2 Caron Tea Cakes (Color in photo is called 'Oolong')

9.0mm hook (N hook)

Tapestry needle and Scissors to finish off

Pattern notes:

The finished size for this scarf is 7.5inches in width and 84inches in length.

If you'd like to make the width of the scarf wider, simply add on to the beginning chain.

If you'd like to make the length shorter or longer, simply make less or more rows.

The stitch used is called 'paired half double'

HDC2tog: YO, Insert hook in first stitch, pull up a loop, YO, insert your hook in second stitch, pull up a loop, YO, pull through all loops on hook

The beginning Chain 2 of each row does count as a stitch.

Yarn substitution: Any bulky 5 weight yarn. The Caron tea cakes are marked as Super Bulky, but I personally feel they are more of a bulky 5 weight.

Tip: Use stitch markers to indicate first/last stitch, as sometimes it may be difficult to see.

Pattern

Row 1: Chain 15, HDC into 3rd chain from hook and across

Row 2: Chain 2, HDC2tog over the next two stitches, HDC2tog over the last stitch and the next stitch, continue to HDC2tog across always starting in the last stitch. End the row with the final stitch in the turning Chain

Row 3-93: Repeat Row 2

OR Repeat Row 2 until your scarf is 84 inches in length
