

## Book Sleeve Crochet Pattern



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**Materials** 

Worsted weight yarn (Caron Cinnamon Swirl Cake in Oyster)

5.00mm crochet hook

Tapestry needle & Scissors

Fabric, needle and thread for lining

**Notes** 

This pattern includes two different sized book sleeves. The bigger one is to fit a

standard hardcover book and the smaller on is to fit a standard paperback book.

I suggest adding a lining to the book sleeve, especially the one made for a

Abbreviations: (US terms)

Ch = chain, dc = double crochet, sk = skip

## Hardcover Book Sleeve Pattern

Round 1: Ch 53, join to first st

Round 2: Ch 3, 2dc in first st, \*sk next 2 ch, 3dc in next ch, repeat from \* around, join to top of beginning ch 3, turn

Round 3: Ch 3, 2dc in same sp, 3dc in between each dc cluster, join to top of beginning ch 3, turn

Repeat Round 3 until you have a total of 23 rounds.

Use yarn and tapestry needle to close up the bottom of the sleeve. Lay the book sleeve flat and sew across the bottom. Flip inside out so the seam is on the inside.

## **Paperback Book Sleeve Pattern**

Round 1: Ch 44, join to first st

Round 2: Ch 3, 2dc in first st, \*sk next 2 ch, 3dc in next ch, repeat from \* around, join to top of beginning ch 3, turn

Round 3: Ch 3, 2dc in same sp, 3dc in between each dc cluster, join to top of beginning ch 3, turn

Repeat Round 3 until you have a total of 18 rounds.

Use yarn and tapestry needle to close up the bottom of the sleeve. Lay the book sleeve flat and sew across the bottom. Flip inside out so the seam is on the inside.
